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From Jordan Chariton of Status Coup: "These people are liars! This is a lie!... Well people might say, Jordan, who cares? They're a joke. Well, because, right now, people are looking for a direction in the progressive movement... Where do we go on the Left? Is it MPP? Is it 1/2

Green Party? Is it f*ck it all, let's just do direct action? Is it let's continue to try to elect progressives within the Democratic Party? That's... I don't care. Whatever people want to do. But journalistically, if someone is running an organization, claiming that they are 2/3

like, a 'People's Party', and this stuff is going on, and by the way is no pushing Jimmy Dore 2024, if people want that then Godspeed, and if Jimmy decides to do that, then more power to him. But people need to know that the organization pushing that, has somebody at the top 3/4

repeatedly lying and who's accused, and I think credibly, of sexual impropriety. And that's the point. And you can't call yourself an opposite, Tina, to the Democratic Power corruption, if you're purging board members, if you're lying about it, if you're retaliating..." 4/5

The great contradiction in Jordan's speech comes from his right wing position, "Whatever people want to do [on the left], I don't care." If you don't care what progressives do, what the left decides, why do you report in so much detail on this left party? Only to argue that 5/6

no one should oppose the Democratic Party, since they cannot escape falling into the same behavior patterns of corruption? That should strike people as a right-wing position. We cannot remain indifferent or distracted when such an important issue confronts us. We risk now 6/7

allowing the fascists in to power, the start of a third world war, and the destruction of democracy as part of a return to slavery. We have historical examples of "republics" in which slavery has a legal standing. Democracy in such cases, is merely a word serving the hypocrisy 7/8

of the regime and its ruling class. In order to fight back against such trends, we must expose and eliminate their root causes. They originate in the class divide of capitalist society. They require socialist revolution as the only remedy capable of producing lasting change. 8/8

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
